

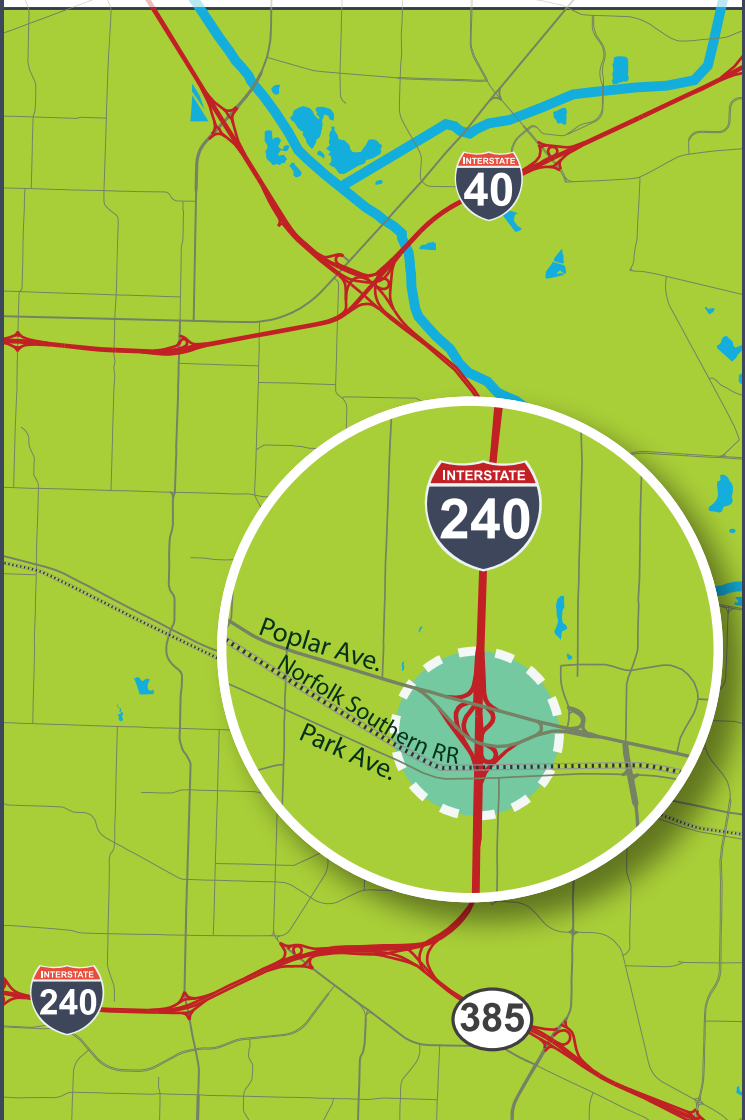
MEMFIX 4



The Project

MEMFIX 4 is a project to repair/replace four bridges along the I-240 corridor in Memphis. These four bridges crossing over I-240 on East Poplar, West Poplar, Park and the Norfolk Southern Railroad were built in 1968 as part of the interstate system through Memphis. In recent years, these 47-year old bridges have required constant attention resulting in repair projects that have created periodic traffic issues for downtown motorists.

The Process

TDOT has carefully selected an innovative process to minimize the inconvenience to motorists. Accelerated Bridge Construction (ABC) will allow repair/replacement of these four bridges to occur in 9 to 12 weekends during the next 12 to 15 months, completing the project in June 2019.

What is ABC?

ABC typically requires a complete weekend shutdown so the contractor can remove the bridge and replace it within a 56-hour period. It's a tedious and highly organized process based on staged removal and then construction of the new bridge from Friday night to Monday morning.

I-240 & Poplar Ave. Closures

The closures will begin in Summer 2018 and specific weekend closures for the next 12 to 15 months will be identified depending on work accomplished and Memphis events. The project will not be active during major event or holiday weekends.

Impacts: Up to 12 weekends of complete I-240 closures, as well as closures on Poplar Ave. at I-240
